This lab is available to any member of the Georgia Tech community that has completed an orientation session on the lab. The lab currently has over 100 active users from multiple schools on campus and offers unique collaboration space for planning, brainstorming and executing projects. While the lab if focused on providing tools and equipment related to creating devices or components best categorized under interactive computing, the lab is also well suited for students of industrial design, electrical and computer engineering, mechanical engineering and architecture. We currently have a large CNC router, table saw, drill/mill, circuit mill, screen printing equipment, 3D printer, laser engraver/cutter and soldering stations. Some of the equipment, including laser engraver and 3D printer, is approaching the end of its useful life and is in need of upgrade or replacement. The active user base of this lab (as well as similar labs on campus) is growing and we need to be able to safely handle the load of additional users so part of the proposal includes safety related upgrades. The laser engraver is highly utilized and as we're needing to cut larger and larger parts, a larger more powerful laser engraver is needed. More and more electronic projects are using surface mount components which require a reflow oven to properly solder components which we currently lack.
